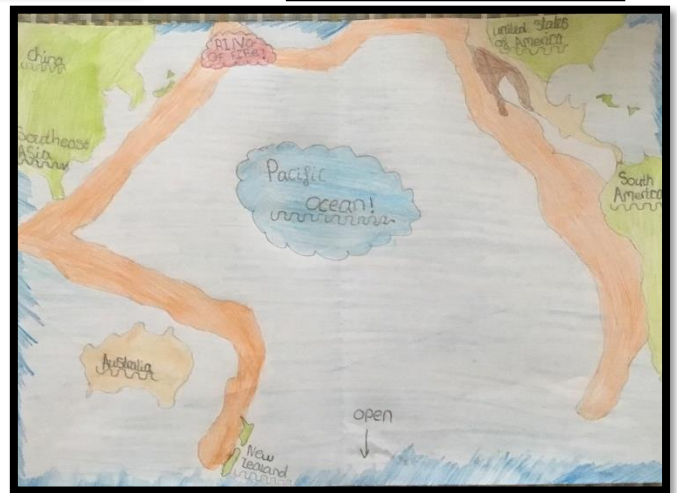


Kit's volcano and ring of fire work

Part of Sarina's volcano and ring of fire work

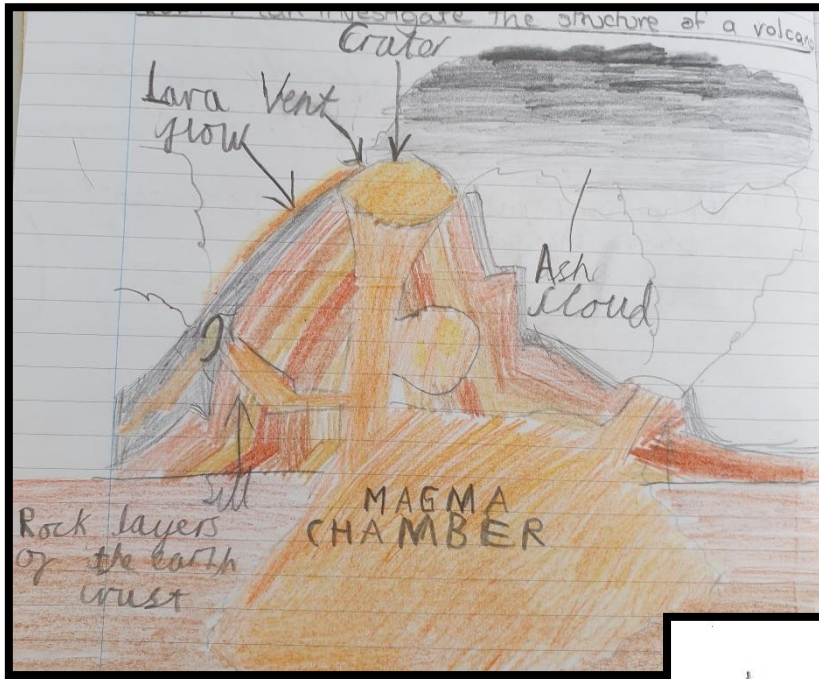


Part of Scarlett P's volcano and ring of fire work

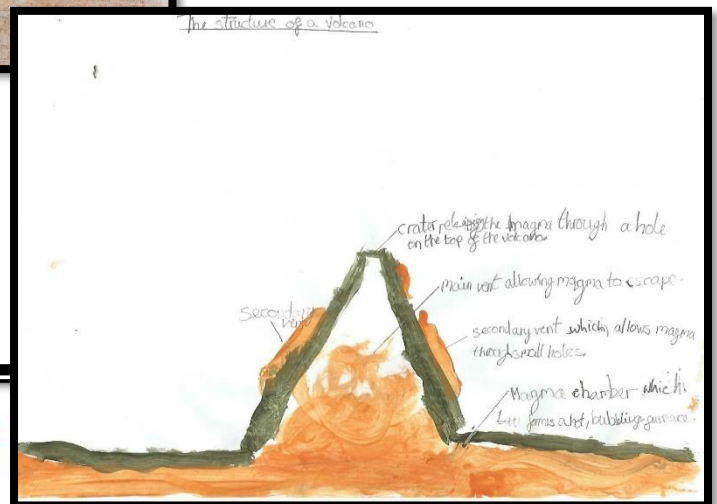

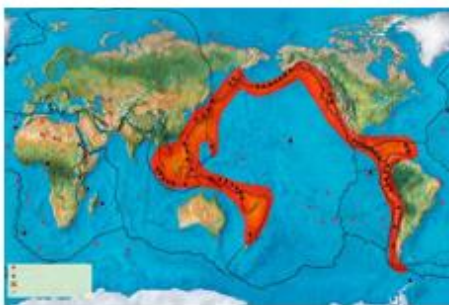

RING OF FIRE

The ring of fire is a chain of volcanoes and earthquakes.



The ring of fire can be found on the edges of a giant Pacific plate.

The most recent activity in the cascade arc was in early 2009 when Mount Redoubt in Alaska became active and erupted on 22nd March. The eruption finished in May 2009.

More than 70% of the world's volcanoes (450) and 90% of earthquakes are around the ring of fire.

The ring of fire is 24,500 miles long.

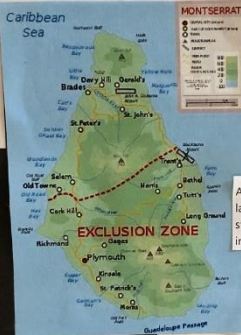
There is an area of the ring of fire in North America that is 700 miles long and is called the cascade volcanic arc, this area includes 20 major volcanoes as well as another 4000 separate volcanic vents.

Montserrat

Is a British Overseas Territory in the Caribbean. The island is in the Leeward Islands, which is part of the chain known as the Lesser Antilles, in the West Indies.

- Land:- Montserrat is 11 miles (18 km) long and 7 miles (11 km) wide.
- People:- The population is largely of African ancestry (black), with small numbers of people of European descent.
- Economy:- Tourism and agriculture were formerly the main economic activities.



A **stratovolcano**, also known as a composite volcano, is a conical volcano built up by many layers (strata) of hardened lava, tephra, pumice and ash. Unlike shield volcanoes, stratovolcanoes are characterized by a steep profile with a summit crater and periodic intervals of explosive eruptions and effusive eruptions.

Montserrat's Volcano.

- Much of Montserrat was devastated and $\frac{2}{3}$ of the population fled abroad because of the eruption.
- Montserrat's Soufriere Hills Volcano erupted because the underlying pressures beneath the rock grew too high and exploded.
- Montserrat's volcano is an active, complex stratovolcano with many lava domes forming its summit on the Caribbean island Montserrat.
- Montserrat's Volcano erupted on July 18th 1995 in the southern part of the island.

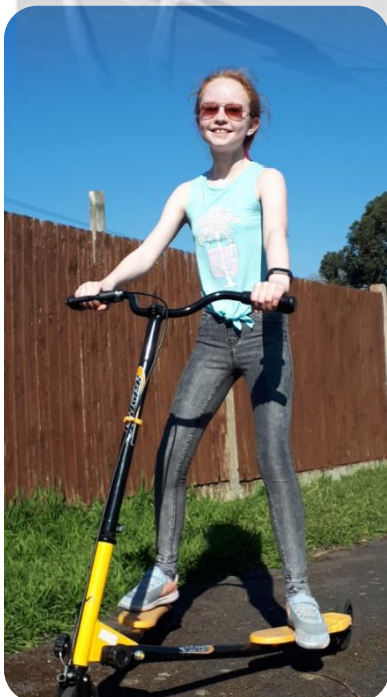
Mount Tambora

Mount Tambora is a volcano located on Sumbawa, an island of Indonesia. The April 1815 eruption of Mount Tambora was one of the most powerful eruptions of the past 10,000 years. Before the eruption it was about 14,000 feet (4,300 meters) high. However it lost much of its top during the eruption.

The eruption of Mount Tambora created a fast-moving clouds of hot rocks and gases. It also caused tsunamis (giant sea waves). These events caused the death of 10,000 people and destroyed 35,000 homes.

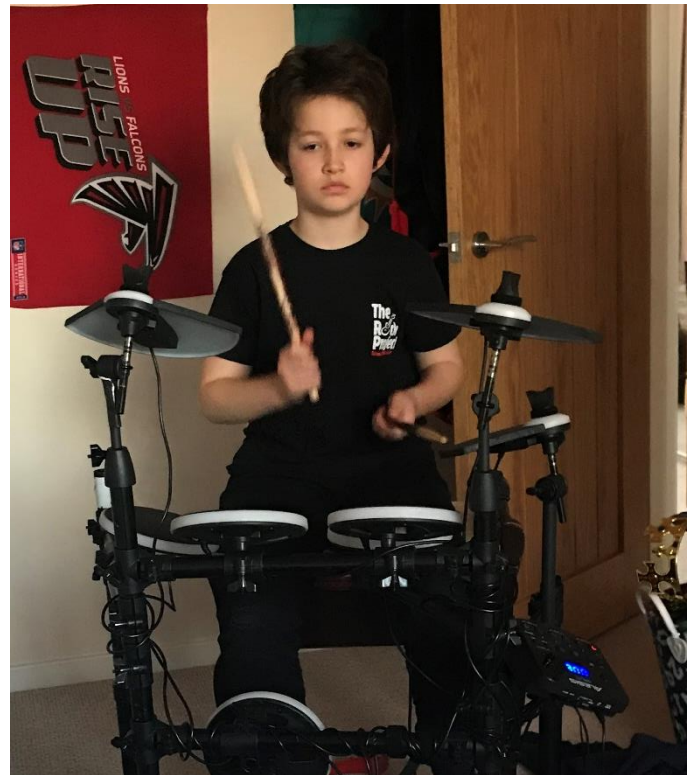

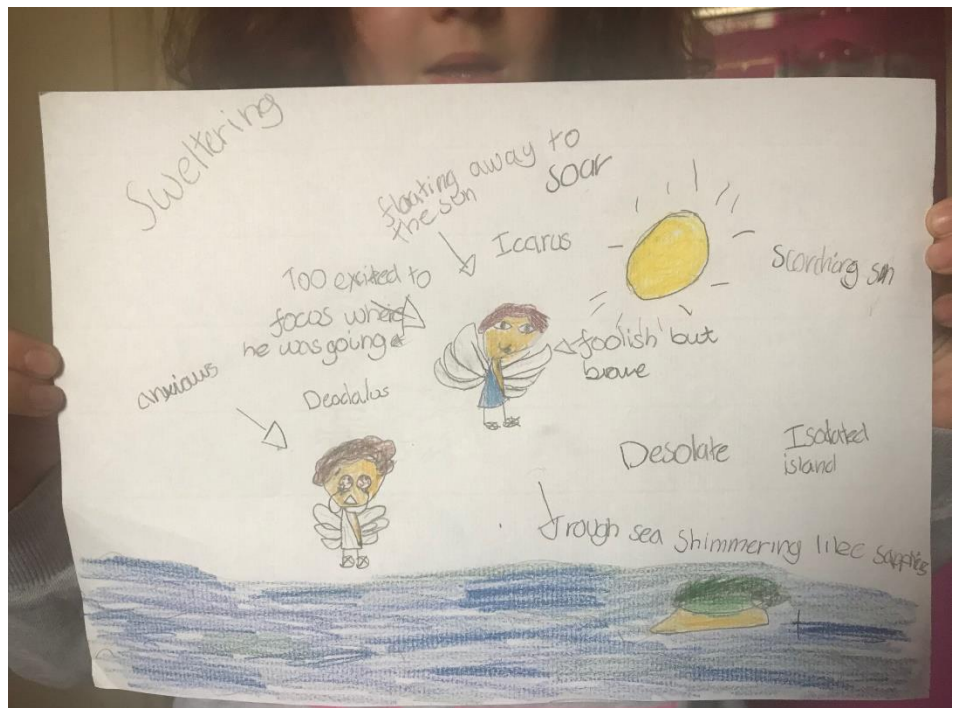

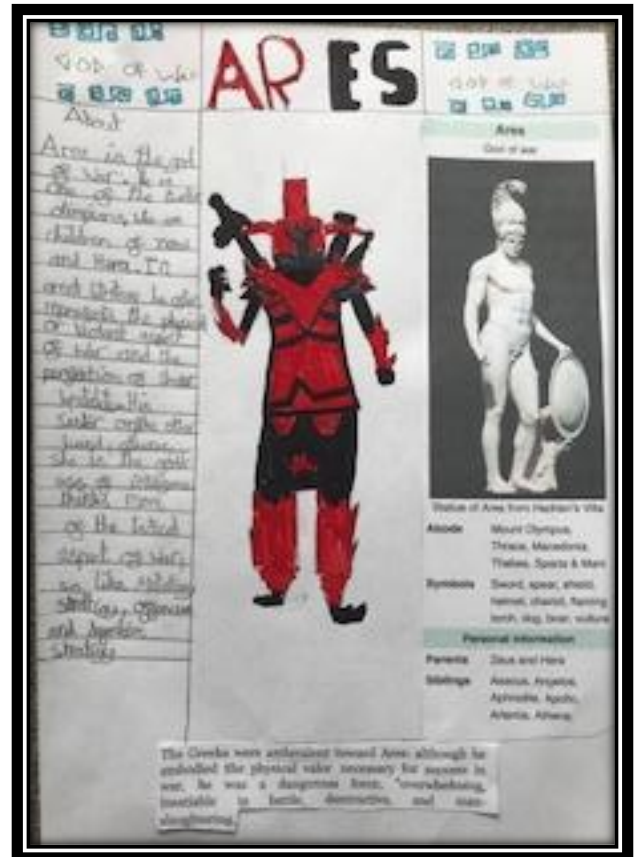

Zeus was the leader of the 12 Greek Olympian gods, who lived on Mount Olympus. He was married to Hera who was actually his sister!

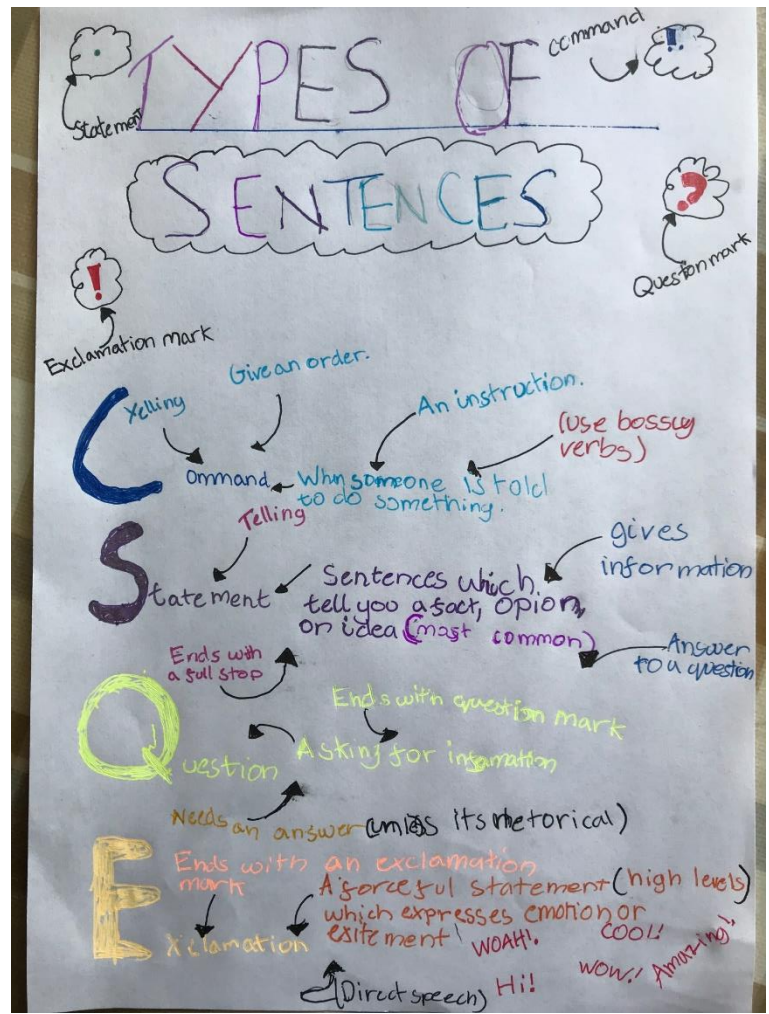


Zeus originally was married to Titan Metis but he started to grow worried thinking that if they had a son he would be stronger than him. So he swallowed her whole then married Hera.

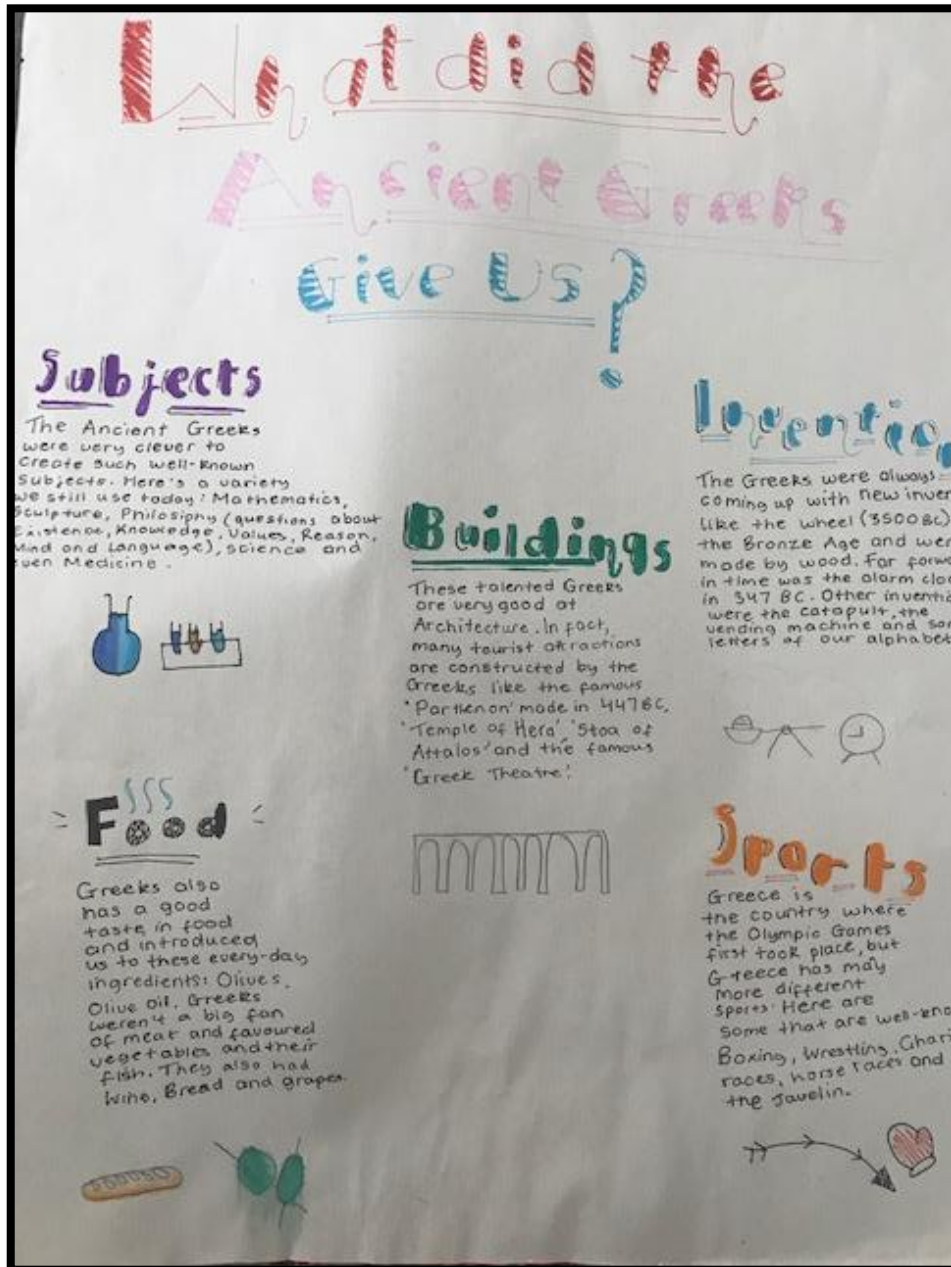

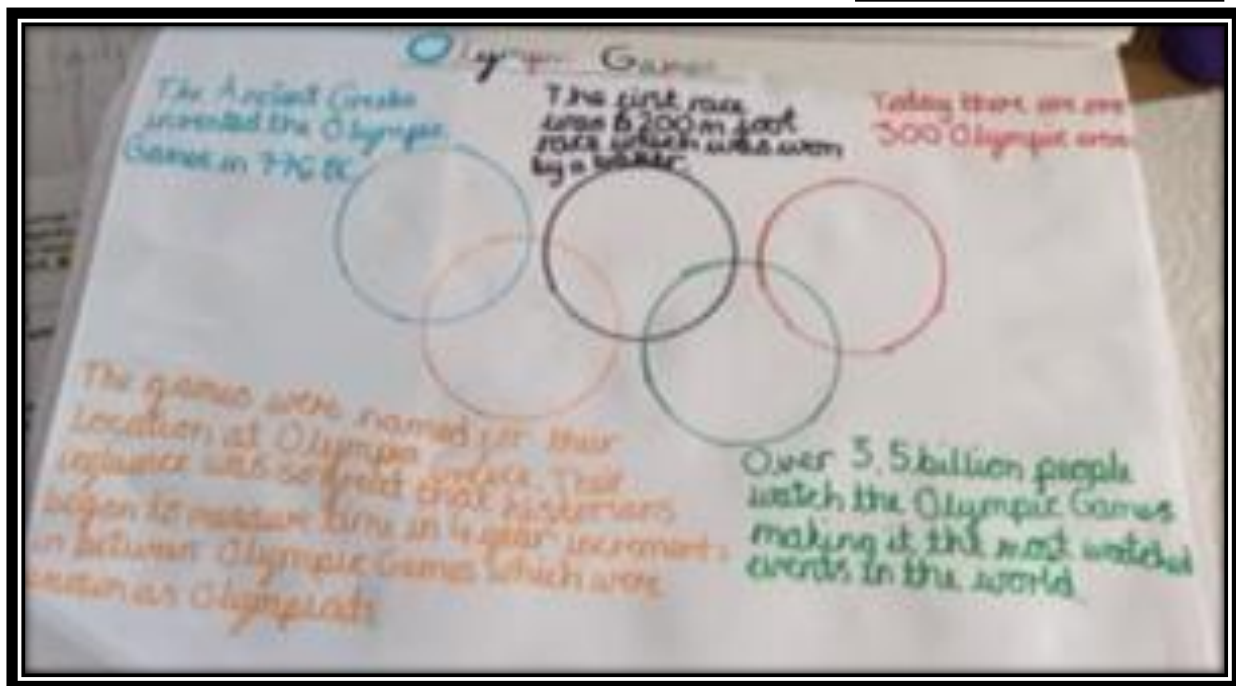

Mount Tambora

Mount Tambora is a volcano located on Sumbawa, an island of Indonesia. The April 1815 eruption of Mount Tambora was one of the most powerful eruptions of the past 10,000 years. Before the explosion was about 14,000 feet high. However, it lost much of its top during the 1815 eruption. It now stands 9348 feet tall. A bowl-shaped pit sits where the top was - 4 miles across, 4101 feet deep.

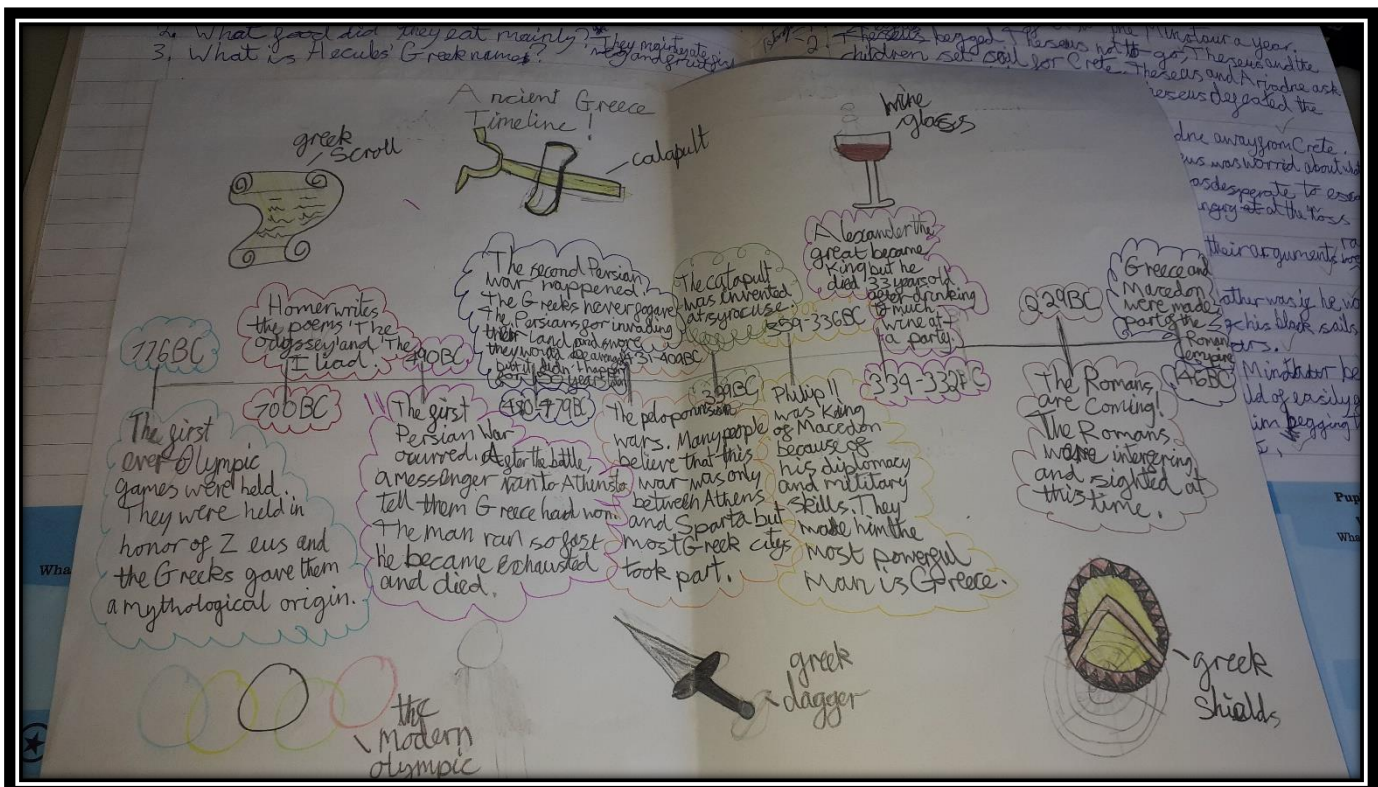
The eruption caused a moving cloud of hot rocks and gases which caused tsunamis - It killed 10,000 villagers and 35,000 homes. This led to crop failures which starved 80,000 people.



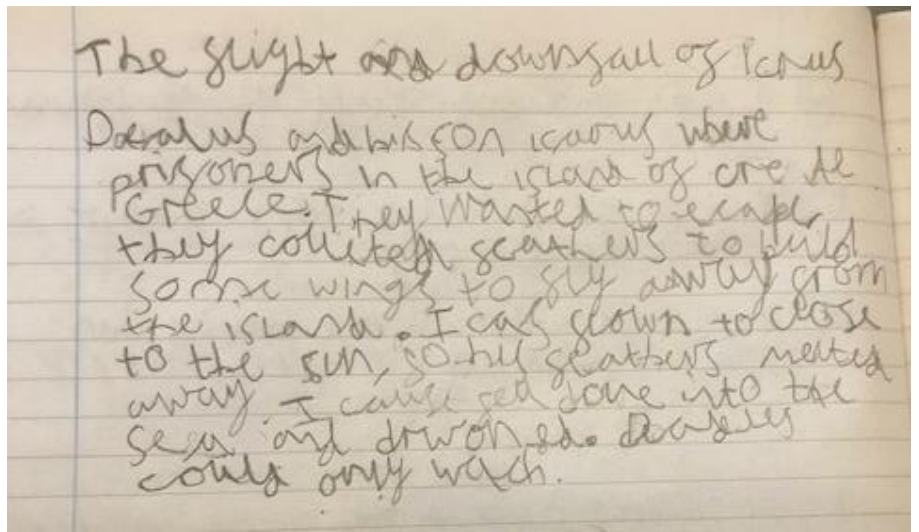
