SATs

Next term, your children will complete the 'Standard Assessment Tests' (SATs) in the week commencing 13th May. This covers:

- Reading comprehension
- Maths one arithmetic and two reasoning papers.
- Grammar 2 papers (One spelling and one short answer paper)

SO PLEASE:

- Read listen to your child every night and ask questions about what your child has read. - quality not quantity!
- Times tables practise speed and recall to support calculations.
- Support your child with any home learning.
- Have a regular routine to encourage the development of work and play
- Encourage your child to have a sensible bedtime.

Changes: This term the children may also be given practice papers and ten-minute tests to develop their understanding in different areas. These will be given out when appropriate - details will be in homework diaries.
