Topic

Science

Children will compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal) and response to magnets.

Learn that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution and experiment and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.

Indicating degrees of possibility using adverbs and modal verbs

What helps Hindus to worship?

Geography

How do people cope with volcanoes and earthquake in and around Mexico City?

Exploring how the tectonic plates movement causes earthquakes and volcanoes and which countries are most affected by these geographical events.

Art

Who was Frida Kahlo?

Exploring the work and style of Frida Kahlo and the impact of her Mexican heritage on her art.

Home Learning

Home learning is a very important part of school life and the children will continue to need your support to complete their tasks. Tasks will be:

- 1) Reading Please read aloud with your child at least 4 times a week (every night if possible).
- 2) **Spellings** On a Tuesday, your child will be taught a new spelling rule and then given some online spellings using 'Spelling Shed' to practise. They will be tested the following Tuesday.
- 3) Maths home learning Home learning will be set on Fridays every week. This will now be a task from their new Maths

 Journal. They will need to be returned by the following Wednesday when we will go over the task together. Children also need to continue to practise their times tables that they have been given to focus on.
