In English, this half-term, we will work on traditional tales, looking at the fairy story of 'Red Riding Hood' and writing it with an alternative ending. We will explore Spring imagery in poetry and write our own Spring poems. In Maths, we will explore fractions, before moving on to mass and capacity.

## Spring Term 2 Learning

Science: Rock and Soils: Separating and testing soils. Planning, conducting, and evaluating investigations about soils and rocks.

Geography: How to use and draw maps. Exploring compass points and grid references - drawing and locating places and features on maps and giving directions.

Art: We will be studying the artist, Caz Scott, and how she uses line and colour to represent Dorset.
R.E: How did Jesus change lives?
P.E / Games and Gym: Ball skills and gymnastics skills.

Computing: Computer Programing-Scratch
Music: All the learning in this unit is focused around one song: The Dragon Song.

Please note P.E will remain on Tuesday and Thursday this halfterm. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings and watches are removed.

## Home Learning

1) Reading - Please continue to read with your child every night and note it in their home school link books
2) Phonics - phonics books will be sent home on a Tuesday. Children are asked to share their phonics learning for the week with an adult at home and choose three of these phonic sounds and use them in sentences. We will shortly be finishing our phonics scheme and after this, spellings will be set on Spelling Shed and tested weekly on a Tuesday.
3) Times tables - Our focus this term will be doubles, the 2 times table and square times tables.
4) Maths Shed- look out for quizzes to complete online. Children can also independently explore the site.
5) Topic- set half-termly. Sheet to be sent home.

## Reading

It is valuable to hear the children read the books they bring home from school. For some children, a

- second read of the book may be beneficial. The first time they read, will be the time the children become familiar with the book and develop fluency and expression. The second time you can focus on comprehension and ensuring the children have a solid understanding of what they have read. We
- hear the children read a different book in guided reading each week where we explore a book in detail focusing on both skills of reading and of comprehension.
