#### Home learning

The children will continue to receive one piece of home learning per week on a Thursday. This needs to be returned the following week please. Please ensure that you continue to read with your child every night. The children will continue to have the opportunity to change their library book if they wish to do so on a Friday. Thank you! This half term in Sapphire class our learning is based on finding out about different environments and comparing them with our own.

In Literacy we are going to be travelling to Kenya with 'Handa's Surprise', then visiting the Antarctic through 'Lost and Found.' We will end up in space reading 'Whatever Next.' We will also be using non-fiction texts alongside the stories.

In **Maths** we are consolidating the composition of numbers to 10, counting to 20 and beyond looking at patterns. We will look at the parts that make a whole number, including doubles. We will try different strategies for counting, including starting from different numbers, and knowing parts of a whole when a part is hidden.

In **RE** we are finding out about **What Makes Something Special**, things that are special to the children, at school, and how some things remind people about God.

**PE** will continue to be on a **Wednesday** with Mr Orriss. Hopefully as the weather improves we will be outside more often.

Long hair needs to be tied back and earrings removed so children can participate.
