In English

- Reading and writing a traditional tale
- Writing recounts
- Improving our use of punctuation including! and?
- Adding s or es to show a plural.
- Preparation for Phonics Screening Assessment

In Maths

- Multiplication and division
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Finding a half and a quarter of an object, shape or quantity
- Geometry: Position and direction, forwards, backwards, left, right, above and below.
- Ordinal numbers

In **Science** the focus is 'Plants' and we will be investigating' how a seed becomes a plant or tree'.

In R.E - What is the Torah and why is it important to Jewish people?



In **Computing** - How can we move a robot? (Bee-Bots) In **Geography**- Is Britain and island?

In **DT** - What is a healthy snack? Making good food choices and how to make a healthy snack

Home Learning

Reading and Spelling

Please can reading books and Home School Link books come to school every day. Please comment about how your child has got on and practice re reading as this really benefits their fluency and supports their comprehension skills. The tricky words for each week are sent home each Friday along with the 'I can blend' sheets. The books we send home are aligned to Rocket Phonics program so it is super important that they do read these.

Topic

Maths

Dig1t games will be given out from time to time to play at home. These do not need to be returned to school.
