We begin this summer term with some new
topics. We will be learning about Ancient Egypt
as well as light and shadow in science.
In English, we will begin by completing work
based on the story 'The Firework Maker's
Daughter' by Philip Pullman. We will then be
writing non-fiction chronological explanation
texts about the seven-stage process of
mummification linked to our topic work.

In Maths, we will continue to work on fractions, and then move onto money, time, shape, and statistics.

During Summer Term 1, the theme for Year 3 is Ancient Egypt and Light. Many subjects will have this theme included.

Science: Light - What is light, what is dark? Name light sources. Can light pass through objects? How are shadows formed? What is reflection?

Art: Creating Egyptian artwork using a range of media and creating Egyptian portraits.

History: Beginning to use a range of historical resources to investigate life in Ancient Egypt - their daily activities, beliefs and how they communicated.

RE: Sikhism- What do Sikhs value?

PSHE - New starts and transitions

PE/Games: Athletics and striking and fielding games

Modern Foreign Language: French - Months of the year and birthdays.
