Practise telling and writing the time using both a digital and analogue clock.</p>	<p>Can you say in French which month of the year you were born in? Practise saying the months of the year in French.</p>
<p>Do you have a favourite book character? Write a character description of your favourite character. Write about what they look like, act like, what they have feelings about and what type of character they are.</p>	<p>What time of the day are shadows longest? Can you draw a picture/diagram to show how shadows might be different during the day</p>	<p>What do plants need to grow? Plant a seed. Make a diary to record what happens. Did you need to do anything to help the plant grow?</p>
<p>Can you write a poem about Ancient Egypt? Include at least one poetic device e.g., rhyme, alliteration, simile, metaphor, onomatopoeia.</p>	<p>Research how the Ancient Egyptians portrayed themselves.
