English

The Explorer by Katherine Rundall (Narrative openers, descriptive writing and diary writing from different characters perspectives)

Science

Home Learning

Home learning is a very important part of school life and the children will continue to need your support to complete their tasks.

Tasks will be:

- 1) **Reading** - Please read aloud with your child **at least 4 times a week** (every night if possible).
- 2) **Spellings** - On a Tuesday, your child will be taught a new spelling rule and then given some online spellings using 'Spelling Shed' to practise. They will be tested the following Tuesday.
- 3) **Maths home learning** - Home learning will be set on Fridays every week. This will be several pages from their Maths Practice journals to link to what we have covered in class. Please make sure your child completes the relevant pages and returns the book to school to mark together the following Friday.
- 5) **Topic homework** - This should be completed every two to three weeks, using an idea from the grid attached.

If you would like extra home learning, you could purchase CGP guides for extra practice for English and Maths.

Amber Class PE days

- Our PE lessons will be on a **Tuesday and Friday**. Please make sure your child arrives at school in school kit suitable for PE.
- Please ensure your children do not wear earrings, jewelry and have their hair tied back for PE.
- Tuesday will be outdoor PE- Games this half term.
- Friday will be inside - Dance this half term.

Reading books -

Children should have their reading books and reading records every day. Children need to have their records signed before they change their book.

Reading to and with your child is crucial for their development. Fluency in reading is an important skill, but it is vital children are asked questions about what they are reading to develop their comprehension of texts.

We strongly suggest a range of literature - fiction stories, poetry, child newspapers, information texts and biographies.

Remember, they are not too old to have a bedtime story and hearing you read, helps them develop their tone and rhythm.
