Reminders

Please ensure your child has a coat that they can do up, wellies, bottle of water and a healthy snack in school with them every day (**all named**).

Children start their learning as soon as they arrive (before registration) which includes reading to an adult, handwriting and phonics activities.

P.E will continue to be on **Wednesdays and Fridays**. Please ensure your child comes into school dressed in full PE kit, with earrings removed and long hair tied back.

Home Learning

Please try to read with your child every night and send in their **home school link book and reading book** to class every day. It is helpful if you can initial the home school link book and write a comment about how they have done.

Phonics 'I can blend' and **Spellings** will continue to be given out on a Friday and a **Maths** game from time to time to complement our curriculum.

We will also continue with the learning grids that cover our **topic, Maths and English**. Over the half term, two pieces of your child's choice need to be completed and handed in. Please see the Home Learning grid for more details.
