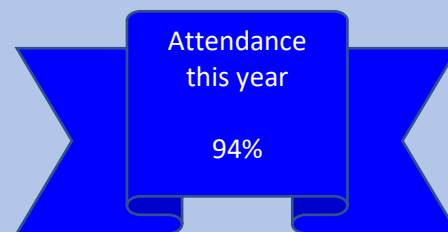
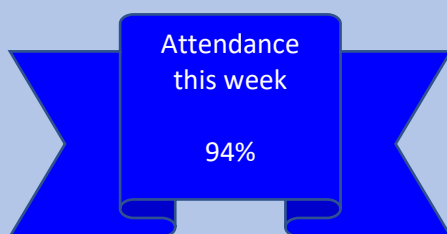
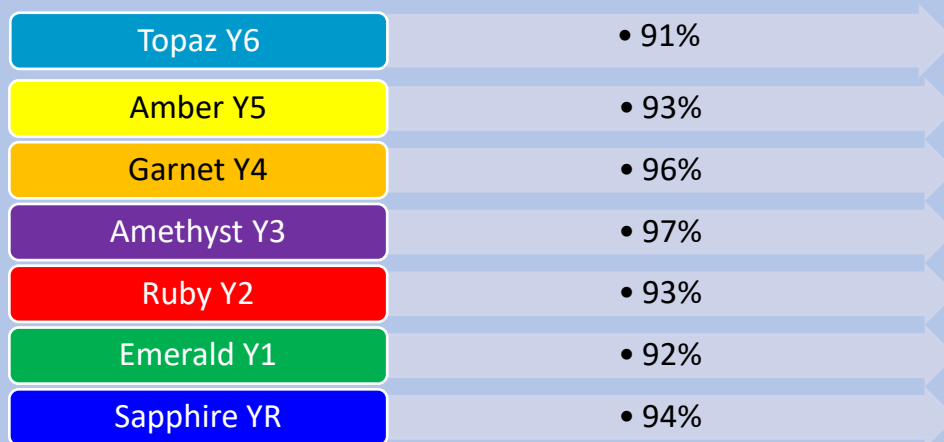
Team points are awarded for excellent attitudes towards learning and excellent behaviour attitudes.
