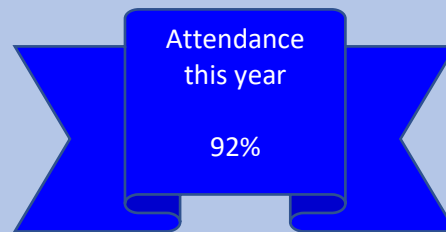
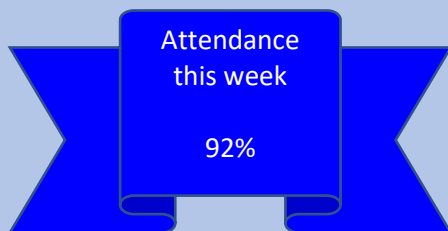
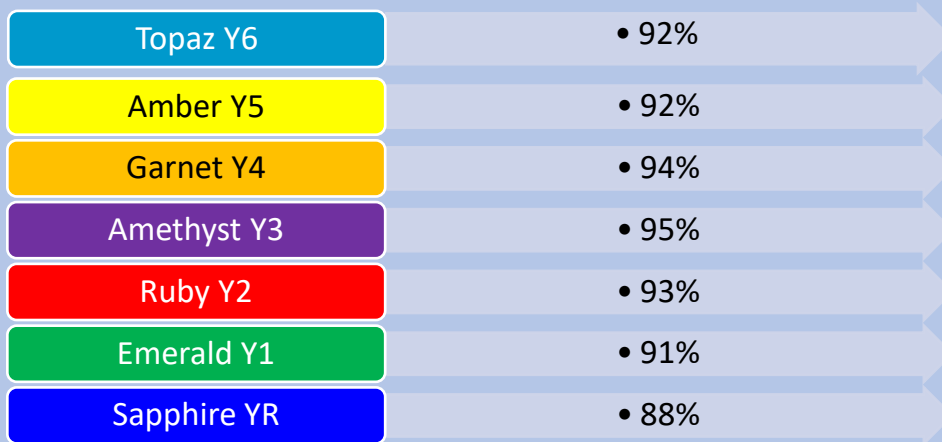

A forest song for us to hear.

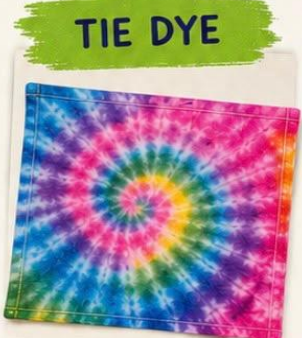
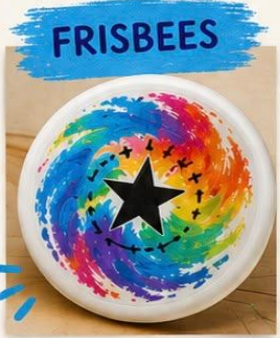
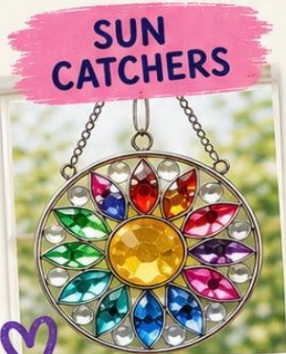
Upon the stage we took our turn,
